As we move into summer, we will start looking at fractions and measurement, including time.



Reading at home

We are starting to see the number of children reading 3 or more times a week, creeping up, although Cherry are still very much in the lead! Reading just 10 minutes a day can increase a child's reading fluency substantially, making it easier to access not just a wider variety of texts, but more work across the curriculum and new vocabulary that will push them forward in their English Writing skills. Reading is the key to it all!

We do our best to make sure the children pick-up and keep their own jumpers and hoodies, but having a name in them makes it a lot easier. If a jumper does become lost, let us know and we'll have a good search, but an alternative green jumper would be preferable to a different coloured one.

Home learning

We will send home the log-ins for both 'Teach Your Monster' and Times Tables Rockstars' again for this half term. The children have loved practising their multiplication facts in school and it has really supported them with their Arithmetic





skills. It is important they are getting to know their facts fluently as they should be very familiar with 2, 5 and 10s times tables by the end of Year 2 and beginning to recognise their 3 times tables as well. Even just writing them out regularly with help to get them sticking in their minds!
