Students need to continue practising their times tables. All students have a Times Table Rockstar (TTRS) login for use at home and in school. Please let us know if your child needs a reminder of this.





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
### **Reading and Writing**

This term, we will be continuing to read *Letters from the Lighthouse* by Emma Carroll.

The children are excited to find out more about the mysteries of Budmouth Point :

- \* Will the lighthouse be destroyed?
- \* What are Queenie and Ephraim hiding?
- \* Where is Sukie?
- \* What does the code mean?

In Year 6, the students also get introduced to a new picture book and chapter book every week, which they are encouraged to borrow and read independently.



In addition to *Letters from the Lighthouse*, we will also be reading Shaun Tan's *The Arrival* to inspire our writing. This classic, wordless graphic novel perfectly expresses what it means to leave your country and your family and start a new life in a new

#### Other Areas of the Curriculum

In **Science**, students will be learning about **Evolution and Inheritance**. Students will be taught to identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways, and that adaptation may lead to evolution. Pupils will recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.
